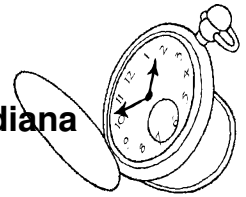

GENERAL CAMPER INFORMATION

The Diabetes Youth Foundation of Indiana is eagerly awaiting the arrival of your child. The staff will undergo an extensive training program to ensure that your child's stay is both enjoyable and safe. We are well aware of the significance of the trust you have placed in us by enrolling your son or daughter in our camping program. All of us at the DYFI Camp for Children with Diabetes will do our very best to show you that this trust was well placed. We feel that each counselor, program and medical staff member must be comfortable with diabetes and prepared for any potential problem - just as you are. Please relax and enjoy the time that your child spends with us. We're confident your son or daughter will have a great time while learning more about managing diabetes.

DIRECTIONS TO CAMP

The Camp is located to the west of Noblesville, Indiana. It is the former Boys' & Girls' Club Camp. Take US 31 north out of Indianapolis from I-465 to State Road 38. Turn right (east) and go to Hinkle Road (approximately 2 miles). Turn Left (north) on Hinkle Road and to 211th Street (approximately 1 mile). Turn right (east) and follow paved road to gate. At gate turn left (north) and follow gravel road to parking lot. Allow 90 minutes from the south side of Indianapolis. CHECK-IN TIMES

Please note that Central Indiana is now on EASTERN TIME. Please plan your travel times, accordingly.

Monday, **June 14-18** Session I Check in for day campers will be 9 a.m. every day. Please arrive promptly.
Monday, **June 21-25** Session II Check in for day campers will be 9 a.m. every day. Please arrive promptly.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

Park in the main parking area and walk your child to the registration table. PLEASE be aware of children playing in the area. Check-in will take place at the picnic table by the Shelter house. Any medications/personal items should be given to the medical staff/camp staff at check-in. Day campers will have a secure place to put their belongings.

PHONE

Due to limited numbers of phone lines, we do not permit campers to make routine calls. Also, we have found that calls home usually result in homesickness. If an emergency should arise, the camp number is 317/877-1721.

CHECK-OUT

Check-out will be at 3 p.m. every -day. Please pick your child up promptly at the picnic table by the Shelter house. You will be given a handout of the day's activities.

Be prepared to sign in and out your child each day. If another person besides the designated parent checks in or out – please notify the DYF in writing prior to check out. A photo ID is required to check out your child.
